Plan for the day

11am - Meet at Chirnside Primary school.

Address: Chirnside Primary School, Td11 3XH.

Location: As you drive round Chirnside the school is on the A6105 Duns to Berwick road. Just as you arrive at the village on the right or just as you leave its on the left.

1pm - Lunch at Chirnside Community Centre.

Address: Chirnside Community Centre, Main Street West End, TD11 3UF

Location: From the primary school we travel towards Duns on the A6105 then turn right at Kirkgate. Follow the road up to the top of the hill. Before the T junction at the top there is a car park on the Left and the Community Centre is on the right.

2pm - Move to the East End, more trees

Address: East End picnic area.

Location: From the community centre, you turn right at the top of the hill on to Main Street(B6355). Follow this road through the village till you get to the T junction with the B6437 road to Ayton. Turn Left, stay on the B6355, pass the road to Grantshouse (B6437) take the next turning on the left into a small picnic area car park.
